5. Do you have any personal stories you can share to bolster your argument? Describe a related memory in detail. Think about sights, sounds, smells. Who was there? How did you feel? (Refer to memoir writing worksheet for more in depth questions)

6. What do you want your readers to learn from this essay? How do you want them to feel when they are finished reading it?

7. What will your call to action be? (A call to action, or CTA is the action you are going to urge people to take to start solving the issue you're critiquing)
