✦ Revise

ARMS

- ADD** words or sentences to improve your writing

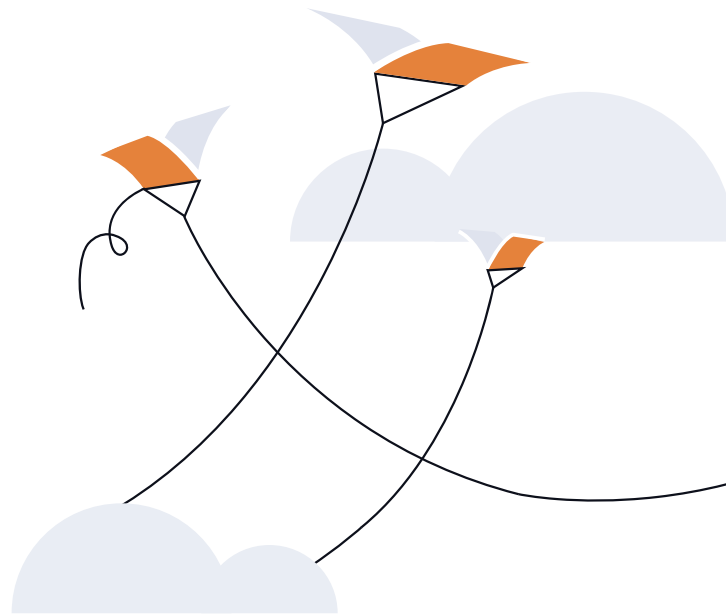
- REMOVE** words or sentences you do not need

- MOVE** order or placement of words or sentences

- SUBSTITUTE** words or sentences for new ones with more specificity

✦ Edit

CUPS

- CAPITALIZE** beginning of sentences, names, places, etc.

- USAGE** match nouns and verbs correctly so the sentence makes sense

- PUNCTUATION** at the end of sentences and as needed (, ; " ")

- SPELLING** check all words, use your resources
