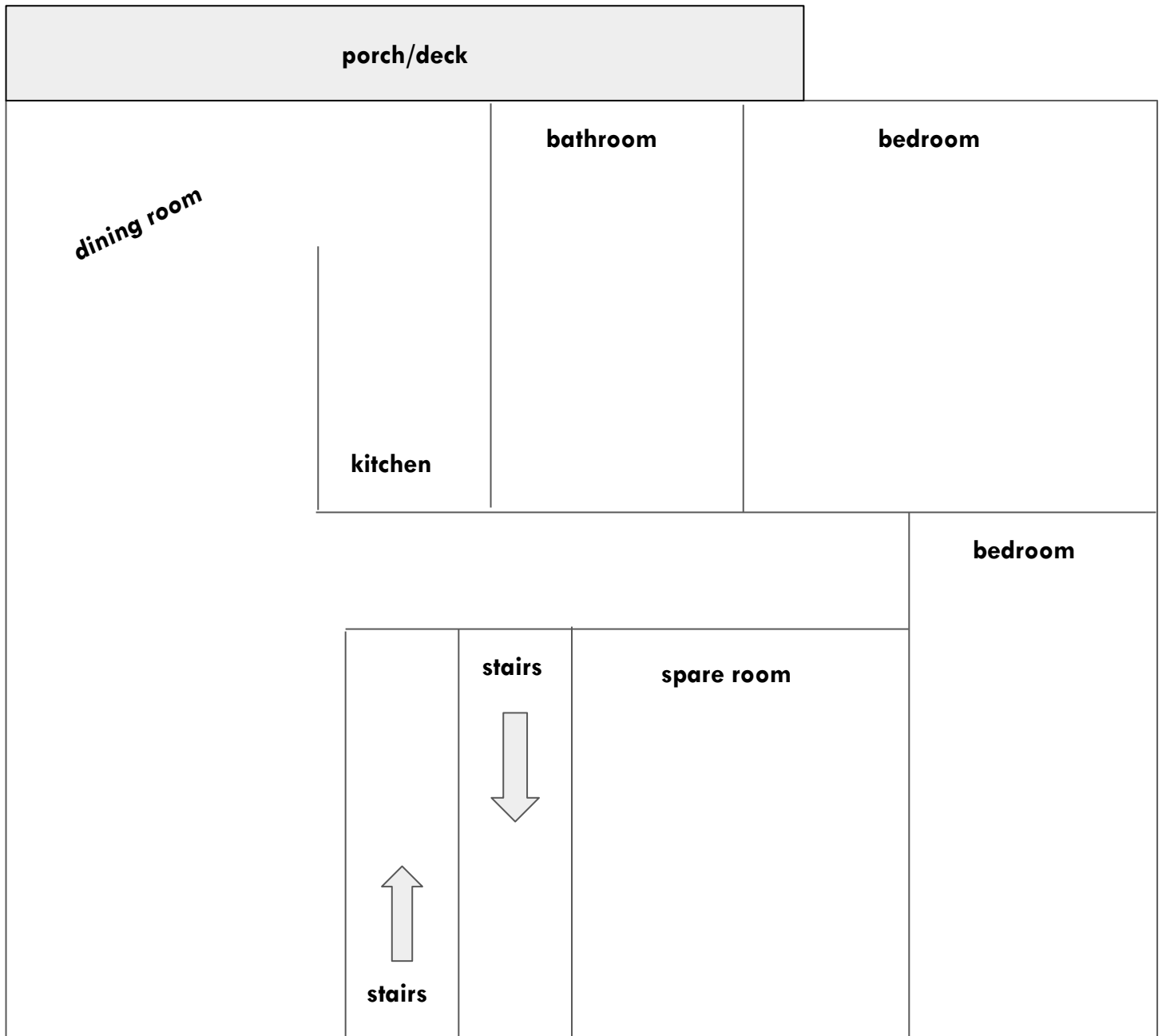


# Your Floor Plan

# Floor Plan Example

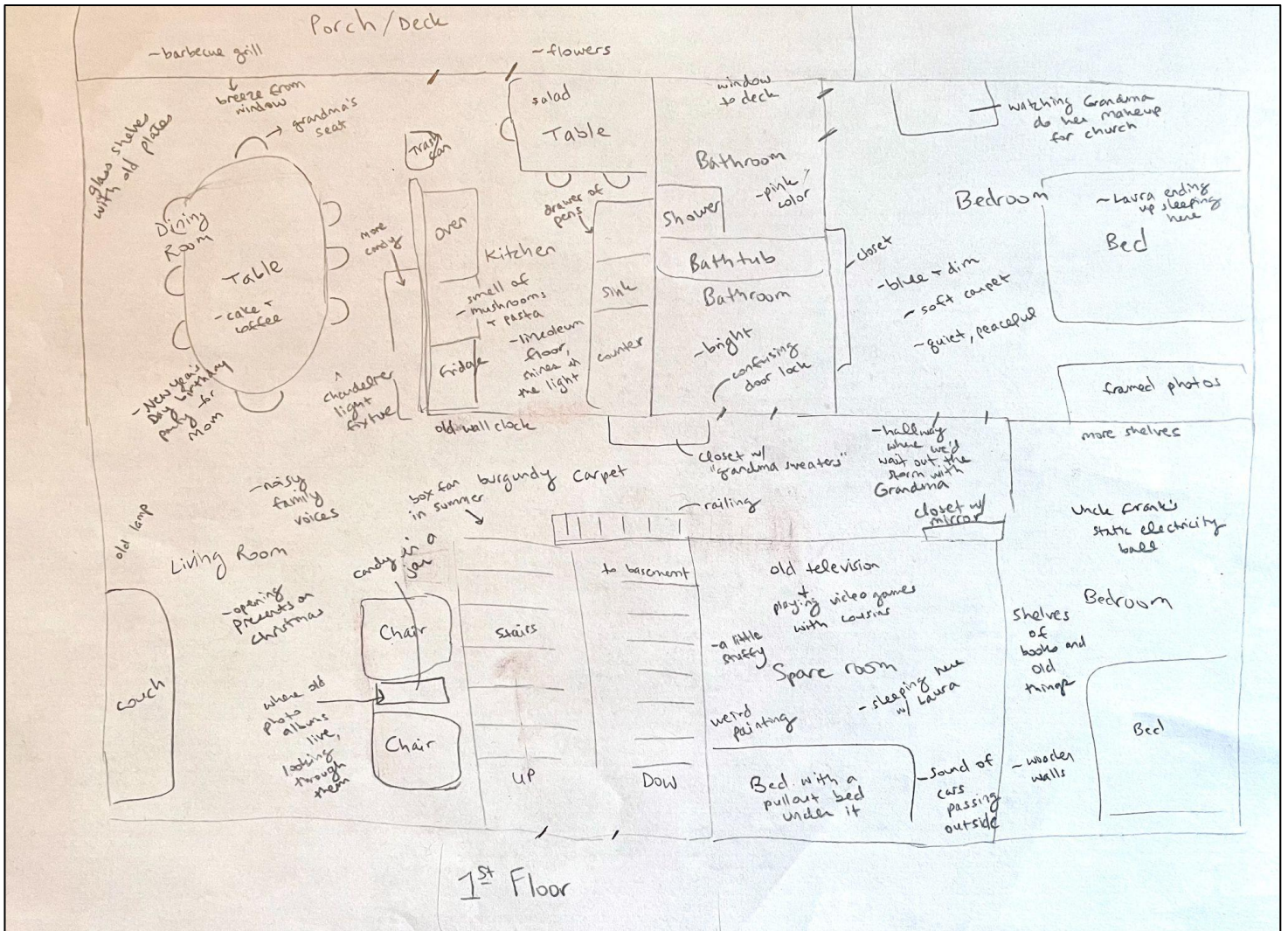
